# ACADEMIC ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Admission to Australian Learning Group (ALG) is determined by a student's ability to meet minimum academic requirements, English language proficiency requirements and prerequisites for the course.

The table below outlines ALG's academic entry requirements:

Course Level	Academic Entry Requirements
Certificate III	Australian Year 10, 12 (ECEC) or equivalent and above
Certificate IV	Australian Year 10 or equivalent and above
Diploma courses	Australian Year 12 or equivalent and above

Admission into the courses below is determined by the student's ability to meet the academic prerequisites as outlined on [ALG's website](#) for each course.

## Providing Evidence of Meeting Academic Entry Requirements

All academic documents must be uploaded as per the designated application process. Students must provide a copy of official transcripts of academic records, as well as the awarded certificate where the qualification was successfully completed.

Where the academic documents are not in English, students must also provide copies of the following documents:

- The transcript of academic records showing results in the language of origin
- The awarded certificate in the language of origin (where the qualification has been completed)



- An English translation of all academic documents
- A copy of the relevant grading scale where available
